CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Children are a priority at SSFBC. We love them, and desire for them to learn who God is, and that He has a plan for their lives. Every aspect of our children's ministry strives to provide a firm foundation based on biblical truth. We want to partner with parents to see their children grow strong in the Lord.



Children's ministry volunteers work as a team to provide both care and biblical instruction to all children birth through sixth grade on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights. Volunteers may serve in multiple areas within the Children's Ministry. All volunteers must be willing to submit to a background check and child protection training.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEAM

TIME VARIES. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

The Children's Ministry Team works closely with the Children's Minister to see that the mission of SSFBC's Children's Ministry is fulfilled. Responsibilities include: Plan, organize, and supervise special functions, social and educational, for the children throughout the year. Assist in overall planning for Vacation Bible School. Oversee planning of children's camps, recruiting children and sponsors. Review and recommend to the Stewardship Committee the budget for all children's activities.

SUNDAY MORNING CHECK-IN TEAM

1 HOUR PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

This team assists members and guests in the Children's Check-In areas by welcoming children and parents, and answering general questions about the Children's Ministry on Sunday mornings. Team members are scheduled on a rotating schedule.

NURSERY OR PRESCHOOL VOLUNTEER

(NEWBORNS - 2 YEAR OLDS) OR (2 & 3 YEAR OLDS)

1.5 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

This team provides care for all babies and toddlers, engages children in simple songs, puzzles, play, and teaches children that God made them. Team members may serve during the Sunday school hour or worship hour. Teens (14-years-old) through adults may serve on this team and are scheduled on a rotating schedule.

PRESCHOOL SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER

(NEWBORNS - 2 YEAR OLDS, 2 & 3 YEAR OLDS, OR 4 & 5 YEAR OLDS)

**1.5 HOURS PER WEEK NOT INCLUDING PREP TIME.
MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.**

This team teaches our pre-kindergarten children each Sunday during the Sunday school hour. Teachers teach a Bible story, simple games and crafts. All curriculum and supplies are provided.

SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER (KINDERGARTEN - 6TH GRADE)

**1.5 HOURS PER WEEK NOT INCLUDING PREP TIME.
MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.**

This team teaches the Bible lesson using a variety of activities, crafts and games during the Sunday school hour. All curriculum and supplies are provided.

KIDS WORSHIP VOLUNTEER

1.5 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

This team worships alongside our kids in a service designed for Kindergarteners through 4th graders. Team members assist the Kids Worship leaders with crafts, games, and small group discussion. Teens (14-years-old) through adults may serve on this team and are scheduled on a rotating schedule.

CAMP SPONSOR

3 NIGHT, 4 DAYS. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

Accompany students to pre-teen camp.

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL VOLUNTEER

4 DAYS DURING SUMMER. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED FOR STATION LEADERS.

VBS is SSFBC's largest evangelistic outreach of the year. There are many service opportunities available of varying time commitments.

Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed. AWANA is a global, nonprofit ministry committed to the belief that the greatest impact for Christ starts with kids who know, love and serve Him. Most jobs in AWANA don't require a lot of preparation in terms of creating a curriculum or preparing materials, but rather require you to prepare your heart to show love and respect to these clubbers as we lead them into a clearer understanding of who they are in relation to the Creator of the universe Who loves them dearly. All volunteers must be willing to submit to a background check and child protection training.

COMMANDER

4-6 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

(INCLUDES 1.5 HOUR CLUB MEETING)

Oversees the entire AWANA club experience for the church. Responsibilities include communicating vision, shepherding leaders, managing administrative duties and communicating to church leadership, parents, children and leaders. Responsible for opening and closing club and for discipline during club.

CLUB DIRECTOR

3-4 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

(INCLUDES 1.5 HOUR CLUB MEETING)

Oversees one age-specific AWANA club or youth program. Responsibilities include communicating vision, shepherding club leaders in that age group, managing administrative duties and communicating to the Commander and other church leadership.

LARGE GROUP (COUNCIL TIME) TEACHER

2-3 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

(INCLUDES 1.5 HOUR CLUB MEETING)

Teaches children or youth age-appropriate Bible lessons in a large group setting.

LEADER

2-3 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

(INCLUDES 1.5 HOUR CLUB MEETING)

Builds relationships with a small group of children or youth to help them learn and understand handbook sections and Bible lessons. Actively participates in all club segments.

ATTENDANCE SECRETARY

1 HOUR PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

Greeting, check in, name tags and maintenance of attendance for club night.

CLUB SECRETARY

4-6 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

Provides administrative support by maintaining attendance and achievement records, tracking inventory and placing orders. May support one or more clubs, ensuring set up prior to club meeting.

GAME DIRECTOR

1.5-3HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

Plans and leads age-appropriate games during Game Time. May direct Game Time in one or more clubs on the same night.

STORE DIRECTOR

2-3 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

Maintains the AWANA reward store where club members "spend" points earned during the club meeting. Includes organizing items on the shelves, staffing store when open during club meetings and keeping leadership aware of inventory and other needs.

FOOD SERVICE DIRECTOR

2-3 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

Help plan pre-club snacks, supervise preparation, serving of the food and clean up.

FOOD SERVICE HELPER

1-2 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

Work with Food Service Director in preparation, serving and clean up of pre-club snacks.

All volunteers must be willing to submit to a background check and child protection training.



YOUTH MINISTRY TEAM

TIME VARIES. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

Youth ministry team members will assist in the planning, organizing, and implementing of youth events throughout the year. Responsibilities include: Work alongside the Youth Minister to shape the vision and direction of SSFBC's Youth Ministry. Plan, organize, and supervise special events for the youth. Review and recommend to the Stewardship Committee the Youth Ministry's budget.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT LEADER/HELPER

2 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

Leaders will be at Youth on Wednesdays from 6:30-8:30 pm to help with set up, clean up, lead small group discussion time, and ensure the Bible study goes smoothly.

SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER

1.25 HOURS PER WEEK. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

Teachers will teach student small groups on Sunday mornings from 9:00-10:15 am. Curriculum is provided, and there is very little prep time.

CAMP SPONSOR

4 NIGHTS, 5 DAYS. MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

Accompany students to youth camp.

CRISIS RESPONSE TEAM

Teams help those in need by meeting physical needs, including clean-up, clearing brush, and construction. Teams may be sent out to affected areas in the state or to the homes of local families in need.

DEPLOYABLE TEAM MEMBER

TIME VARIES. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

Deployable teams assist in clean-up after natural or man-made disasters to show the love of Christ to all affected. Team members will be trained by an outside organization such as the Texas Baptist Men, Minute Men, or North American Mission Board, before being sent out in response to a disaster. Deployment to a disaster affected area can last anywhere from three days to two weeks. Jobs while in these areas can range from mudding out homes, feeding those affected, and clearing brush, to construction jobs once the initial clean-up is complete.

LOCAL TEAM MEMBER

TIME VARIES. MEMBERSHIP NOT REQUIRED.

Local teams will consist of responders that will help with families in need in our community. This includes helping families after a disaster, loss of family member, or another life-altering event. Local responders do not need to be trained by an outside organization.

AUDIT COMMITTEE

Audit committee members are responsible to audit all church financial records which will be provided by the church Financial Secretary. This committee will present final Audit findings/ recommendations at the regularly scheduled December business meetings. As with all church committees the chairperson is encouraged to attend council meetings as scheduled.

BUILDING & GROUNDS COMMITTEE

This committee consists of eight members and has the following responsibilities: Oversee the safe-keeping, protection, maintenance and repair of church facilities, furnishings, and attached equipment such as heating, cooling, lighting and storage. Make sure that all furnishings and equipment are working properly. Make recommendations on replacement of worn items or equipment, landscaping, and care of grounds and parking facilities. Make recommendations to the Stewardship Committee as to necessary funds to provide for the annual maintenance of all facilities, furnishings, and grounds.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE

This committee consists of six or more members and has the following responsibilities: Assist the Pastor in matters related to personnel administration and management concerning full and part-time employees. Recruit, interview and recommend prospective employees to the Church.

POLICY COMMITTEE

This committee consists of four members. In addition, the Church Clerk serves as an ex-officio member. Their responsibilities include the monitoring of the Church Policy manual on a continuous basis and recommend changes to the Church as required.

STEWARDSHIP COMMITTEE

This committee consists of six members including the church treasurer and assistant treasurer. Their responsibilities include: supervise and promote the church financial activities and programs, recommend the best financial methods for the Church, draft the annual budget for the new church year and present it to the church, keep members informed on budget allocations, work with the personnel committee on staff salaries, supervise purchasing agents, and promote stewardship as a Christian growth experience.

Membership is required to serve on all committees.



PURPOSE STATEMENT

FIVE PURPOSES OF THE CHURCH

WORSHIP- to worship God is central to our purpose in fulfillment of the great command which Jesus said is, "To love the Lord your God with all your heart." (Matthew 22:37)

MINISTRY- to minister to one another and the world in fulfillment of the second great command which Jesus said is, "To love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 3:39)

EVANGELISM- to witness to the world in order to win people to faith in Jesus Christ in obedience to Jesus' command, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations..." (Matthew 28:19)

FELLOWSHIP- to fellowship with one another for the purpose of encouragement and strength as illustrated in the early church, "They continued steadfastly in... fellowship..." (Acts 2:42)

DISCIPLESHIP- to disciple is the process of teaching Christians and helping each other grow in faith and in the knowledge of God's Word as Christ commanded, "teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you..." (Matthew 28:20)
